

“Wee Bit Irish”

A Complimentary Design by Stitches Through Time

This design is worked using 2 strands of floss over 2 threads on 28 count Antique White linen. Stitch Count: 56w X 56h

Floss Used for Full Stitches:

Symbol	Strands	Type	Number	Color
▲	2	DMC	310	Black
◆	2	DMC	910	Emerald Green-DK
*	2	DMC	3818	Emerald Green-UL VY DK
⌘	2	Gentle Art	0180	Spring Grass

Floss Used for Three Quarter Stitches: Indicated by a small symbol in one corner of a square accompanied by two more of the same symbols. Altogether they form a triangle.

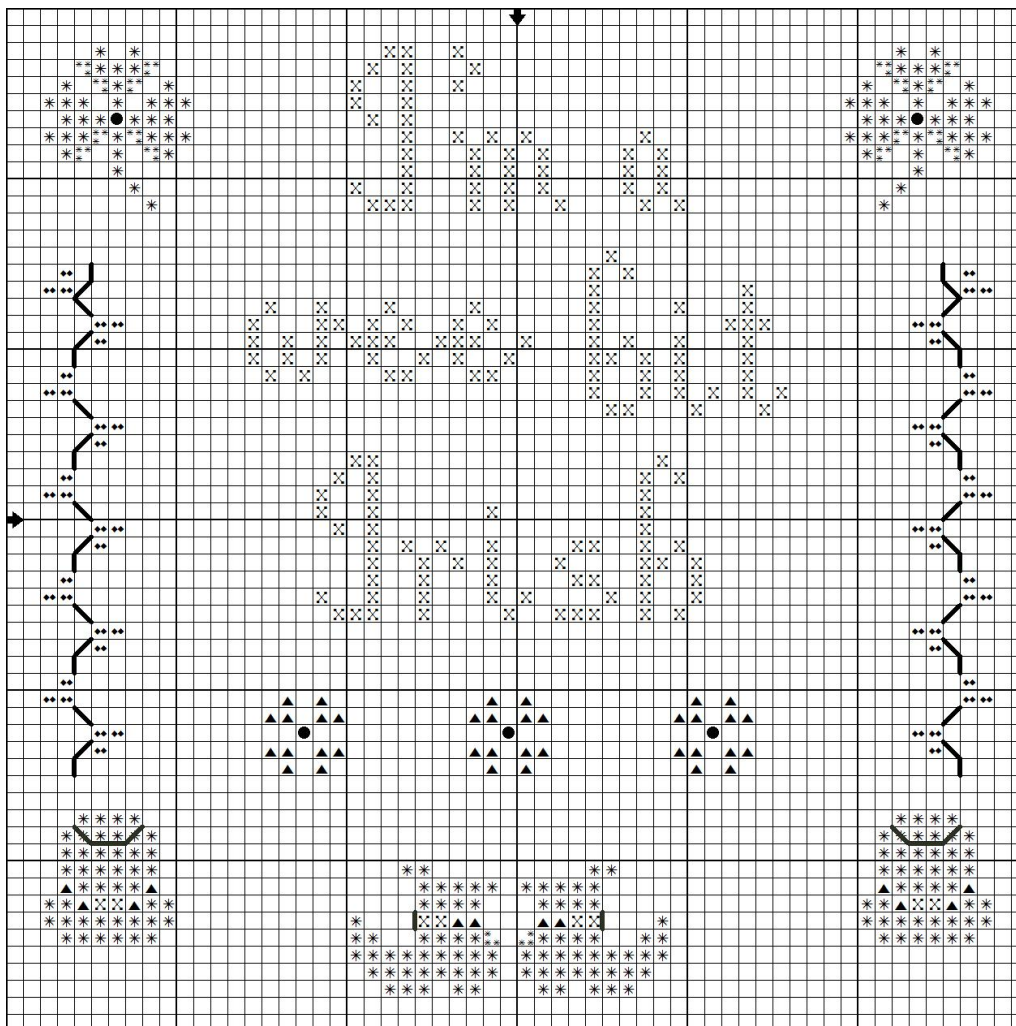
Symbol	Strands	Type	Number	Color	Placement
* (small)	2	DMC	3818	Emerald Green-UL VY DK	On corner shamrocks and boots

Floss Used for Back Stitches:

Symbol	Strands	Type	Number	Color	Placement
— (thin)	2	DMC	310	Black	On top hat and boots
— (thick)	2	DMC	910	Emerald Green-DK	On decorative side designs

Beads Used: Note: If you prefer not to use beads in this design, I suggest 2 -4 strands of GA 0180, Spring Grass in their place.
